Register as an <u>APA Member Student</u> or <u>Non-Member Student</u>, whichever is applicable, then just select the Student Day event (which will show no cost).

REGISTER FOR THE CONFERENCE

Although Student Day will offer tons of great material, the regular conference sessions will cover the latest and greatest in the planning profession. This is also when you will have the best opportunities to rub shoulders with professionals from all over the state. <u>REGISTER HERE</u>. \$50 per day or \$150 for the full conference.

SIGN UP TO VOLUNTEER
